OTHER CREATIVE / SCHOLARLY ACTIVITY

Ongoing: Development of a video library of therapy, assessment, and parent-client counseling sessions of myself and student clinicians for teaching in courses, as well as for teaching specific clinical approaches (e.g. Naturalistic Phonology Therapy, Joint Action Routines, Group Therapy, Behavior Management, etc.).

Spring, 2004. Developed ASmall Talk@, an interactive exhibit to provide parents and young children (aged 0-4) the opportunity to engage in language rich interactions, and to teach parents about language development. The exhibit contains 6 large handcrafted wooden modules, each addressing a different age group. The modules provide a traveling exhibit to be used in various public places in the southeastern Idaho region (e.g. libraries, health departments, hospital lobbies, family services agencies, etc.), exhibited on a rotating basis, to eventually be housed in a permanent facility as yet to be named. This work was completed with an SLP colleague, Sarena Bitton of Portneuf Medical Center and Bingham County Medical Center, via a Maternal & Child Health Grant procured by ASuccess by Six@.

Spring, 2004. Developed parent handouts for ASuccess by Six@ on Communication Development and how to facilitate speech and language growth with children from birth to four years.

Spring, 2003: Developed Departmental Brochure. Developed SLP Division brochure in its entirety and developed a Atemplate@ for all Divisions in our department to use for development of program specific brochures.

Fall, 2003: Awarded \$200.00 grant money from Pocatello Soroptomists in support of Communication Preschool operations.

Fall, 2002-Spring, 2003: Interdisciplinary clinical teaching with Occupational Therapy department (Bill Gibson). Developed and implemented program wherein OT students were involved in the Communication Preschool and SLP students were involved in OT therapy in an interdisciplinary capacity with children exhibiting motor speech and/or speech + limb apraxia disorders.

1998: Received \$15,000 grant funding from the Maternal and Child Health Bureau, managed by Opening Doors Project at Utah State University. Application for this grant was a group effort of the CSHP Task Force. Purpose of the grant: promote activities to improve local service integration and coordinate early intervention services with a medical home.

1999: Development of an award winning Interdisciplinary-Interagency Community Screening Clinic for Infants and Toddlers. Chair, subcommittee of the Pocatello CSHP Task Force charged with developing this clinic under the auspices of the AOpening Doors@ Grant directed by Utah State University. This committee of four developed and implemented a monthly clinic for 0-3 years olds to access free screenings of communication, motor, cognitive, hearing, vision, dental, and medical aspects. This clinic is provided by the goodwill service of Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapists, Developmental Specialists, Speech-Language Pathologists, Vision Specialists, Audiologists, Dental Hygienists, Nurses, Health Educators, and Service Coordinators from Portneuf Medical Center, Bingham Memorial Hospital, Idaho State University, The Idaho Infant-Toddler Program, the Southeastern District Health Department, and Idaho School for the Deaf & Blind. Nine to ten clinics have been held annually for the past 4 years. Continuation indefinitely is planned.

1999: Development of an award winning in-office presentation for Physicians about the Idaho Infant-Toddler Program and the concept of the medical home. This work was done in a group effort by the Pocatello CSHP Task Force.

1999-2000: Development of award winning training modules, videos, and other materials to incorporate a child development and child disabilities training component into the curriculum of the Family Practice Residency Program at Idaho State University.
