**Bachelor of Science Degree: Educational Interpreting for the Deaf (Ed Interp)**

Prior to the acceptance in the Ed Interp program, the department chairperson will conduct an evaluation. Some of the items evaluated are, (but not limited to), the following:

- Prior courses taken in sign language
- Courses taken related to deafness
- Other college/university's sign language studies or interpreting Associates degree

**PLUS**

- An evaluation of the applicant's ASL skills (See [LINK to Ed Interp Application form](#))

The sequence of ASL, interpreting and transliterating course work is critical. All ISU and BSU Core Requirements must be completed by the end of the Ed Interp Year One. The total semester hours required for graduation is 128 credits.
