**Job Description:** Cosmetologists perform a variety of beauty services which cover all phases of the beauty culture such as manicuring, shampooing, hair styling, make-up application, temporary and permanent hair waving, hair straightening, bleaching and tinting, and various skin and scalp treatments. Cosmetologists often specialize in any one or more of these services. The art of hairstyling is no longer the major activity in the cosmetology industry. It has grown to be an increasingly complex and artistic profession. Strong human relations skills and the ability to communicate with people are of major importance.

**Aptitudes and Interests:** Good hand, finger and eye dexterity. Artistic and creative ability. Be able to communicate with people and have strong human-relations skills.

**Educational and Other Requirements:** Completion of high school or GED is required.

**Helpful High School Courses:** Biology, Chemistry, English, Human Relations, Mathematics, Social Sciences

## ADMISSION STEPS

- Complete and return an Application for Admission along with a check or money order for \$40 (non-refundable), payable to Idaho State University. You may also apply online via the Idaho State University home page: [www.isu.edu](http://www.isu.edu). Click on Prospective Students.
- Submit official college transcripts, if applicable, from each accredited institution of higher education that you have attended.
- Submit an official copy of your high school transcript or GED scores (Not required if you have completed and submitted proof of 14 or more academic credits from an accredited institution of higher education.)
- Meet with a College of Technology counselor, if desired, to obtain more in-depth information. To make an appointment, call (208) 282-2622.
- Either:
  1. Complete the COMPASS placement test. This test enables us to place you in the appropriate classes to enhance your success in college.
  2. Submit ACT/SAT scores, valid for seven (7) years from the date of testing. ACT scores are not required for acceptance to the College of Technology, however they are required to qualify for some scholarships
- Apply for financial aid if needed. Questions, call (208) 282-2756.
- Former College of Technology students who have been out of school one semester or more must complete the necessary forms in the Student Services office before returning to the program. Re-entering student must meet the requirements as outlined in the catalog effective at the date of their re-enrollment.

**NAIL TECHNOLOGY** 1/2 semester. Required course: COSM 150. Hours accrued in the Nail Technology option are not transferrable to the Cosmetology certificate.

**COSM 150 PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICE OF NAIL TECHNOLOGY** 11 credits. This course is designed to prepare students for the State Board Examination for Nail Technology Certification. Course activities explore all types of nail care and design methods including manicuring, pedicuring, sculpted nail application, nail care, chemistry, biological concepts, anatomy and physiology of nails, and safety standards and procedures.
