

Procedures for Faculty Referendum on Draft Shared Governance Constitution to occur on Wednesday, November 16, 2011

Eligibility

All ISU faculty members currently under contract at 0.5 or greater FTE with an expectation of continuing employment are eligible to vote. Affiliate and temporary faculty are not eligible.

All polling will occur on Wednesday, November 16, 2011.

All faculty are permitted to vote once and only once and may either of the following two procedures.

Voting Procedure #1

All faculty members eligible to vote may vote in person on a paper ballot at an on-campus polling station on the Pocatello campus.

The polling station will be in the Pond Student Union Building main lobby and will be open from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM.

Presentation of a valid identification will be required to vote in person.

Voting Procedure #2

All faculty members eligible to vote may vote via an absentee ballot cast through stamped US mail provided that the outer envelope meets the criteria below. In this procedure, faculty members print their own ballot, complete it and mail it via stamped US mail to:

An absentee ballot will be accepted if:

The outer envelope must bear the printed name of the person casting the ballot and the signature of the person casting the ballot must appear across the envelope seal. Absentee ballot envelopes must be post-marked November 16, 2011. Mail-in ballots will be unsealed in the presence of a neutral observer and the ballot will be dropped blindly into a ballot box containing multiple ballots.
