**Application Deadline:**

**May 1st for Fall Semester**

**December 1st for Spring Semester**

**Students MUST reapply for Non-Resident Tuition Waivers every year**

**Late applications will not be considered**

**Students who are not admitted with Classified status on deadline date are not eligible to receive a Non-Resident Tuition Wavier**

**Students who have Incomplete (I) grades on deadline date are not eligible to receive a Non-Resident Tuition Wavier**

**Students who have grades of C+ or below on deadline date are not eligible to receive a Non-Resident Tuition Wavier**

**Students who have a GPA below 3.0 on deadline date are not eligible to receive a Non-Resident Tuition Wavier**

- Because students are eligible to re-apply for an NRTW (8 semesters maximum), provided a **3.0** overall GPA is maintained, awards are not made until final grades from the current semester have been posted (typically, final decisions are made in mid-July for Fall Enrollment; mid-February for Spring Enrollment).
- Waivers are awarded based on students' GRE scores and GPA.
- Students must be fully admitted (Classified Admission Status) degree-seeking students in order to be considered for an NRTW.
- There are a very limited number of waivers (40 in Technical Fields; 10 in Non-Technical Fields). Many qualified applicants will not receive a waiver due to the limited number of waivers available.
- Time accrued while receiving a Non-Resident Tuition Waiver WILL NOT contribute toward the length of time required for Idaho Residency status.
- The *Art and Pre-Architecture Department* no longer requires the GRE for admission. HOWEVER, GRE scores are used to calculate eligibility for NRTW awards. Students who do not provide scores will not be eligible to receive a Non-Resident Tuition Waiver.
- Recipients of NRTWs will be notified as soon as possible following determination of awards.
