Institute of Emergency Management Offers Free Training to Idaho First Responders

At the national level, the Office for Domestic Preparedness (ODP) is providing financial assistance to each state and territory to train first responders. This federal funding is being provided to enhance the capability of state and local agencies to prevent, plan for, and respond to incidents involving the use of chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear, or explosive devices (CBRNE).

In Idaho, the Idaho Bureau of Homeland Security (previously the Bureau of Hazardous Materials and Disaster Services) has granted this training responsibility to the Institute of Emergency Management at Idaho State University – Boise Center.

There are already over 20 different courses available on our website for you to sign up for. The standardized IEM curricula will enhance first responders' skills and knowledge about domestic preparedness; help develop additional skills and knowledge for day-to-day activities, and will help first responders prepare for future required exercises.
