**NOTE:** Criteria for evaluating proposals:

- 1) Intellectual merit,
- 2) Likelihood of successful completion of the proposed project,
- 3) National impact potential/plan to disseminate results at the national level
- 4) Sustainability of the project via further funding such as external grants, contracts, royalties, etc.
