

- Name:** **Ted and Florence Jacobsen Scholarship Fund**
- Amount:** The maximum award will be equal to the full-time undergraduate resident tuition, plus a standardized amount for books, supplies, and fees.
- Award Period:** Fall and Spring Semesters -can be renewed for a maximum of 8 semesters
- Major:** Any
- Class Level:** Any but preference to undergraduates
- Enrolled:** Full-time (defined as 12 credits for undergraduates, 9 credits for graduate students)
- GPA:** 2.75 minimum
- Transcript:** Official transcript and current class schedule; freshman or transfer students must submit a copy of the acceptance letter from the institution you will be attending
- Financial Need:** Required
- Citizen Preferences:** ID: (No) U.S.: (Yes)
- Letter of Recommendation:** Two letters required from individuals not related to you who can speak of your character and educational promise.
- Statement:** Submit a one-page, typed letter indicating the need for this scholarship and how it will be used to further your educational goals.  
Renewal applicants need to submit a summary of the prior semester experience using and benefitting from the scholarship.
- Selection Criteria:** Applicant must be an active and worthy member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, and demonstrate financial need by completing and submitting the FAFSA.
