

EXIT INTERVIEWS FOR GRADUATION

All students must apply for graduation by the second week of the semester in which they intend to graduate.

All graduating seniors receiving a B.A, B.S. or M.A in Theatre are required to undergo an exit interview process during the semester of their graduation. The application for graduation must be obtained and submitted through the Office of the **Registrar**.

The requirements for this interview are as follows:

- Each faculty member will prepare a written assessment of each graduating student. These comments will be given to the student upon completion of his/her exit interview.
- Students will complete an evaluation on the Department of Theatre and Dance to be based upon classroom, production, and overall educational experience. The student may or may not wish to discuss the evaluation with the faculty during the interview. Evaluation information may be used to enhance our strengths and weaknesses as a department.

- **Students with an Acting/Directing emphasis must prepare two contrasting monologues (30 seconds each) to present in the interview.**
- **Students with a Technical Theatre emphasis must prepare a portfolio to present in the interview.**
- **Students will prepare a resume and must bring 6 copies to the interview.**
- **The Theatre and Dance Faculty will evaluate the audition/portfolio review with the student following the presentation.**
