

PRACTICUM AND INDEPENDENT STUDY COURSES

The Theatre Program frequently offers practicum courses (THEA 390 And THEA 490). These are usually 2 credit courses, with rehearsal times to be announced. Most typically, these classes are scheduled for longer blocks on Friday afternoons. The early weeks of the semester are devoted to rehearsals, the later weeks to touring, generally to area schools.

Students may apply up to 8 credits of practicum towards graduation, and so can possibly complete a total of four two credit practicum courses. The course can be repeated.

Independent Studies (THEA 393 and THEA 491) must be arranged between the student and the faculty member directing the independent study. It is expected that the student and professor will meet on a regular basis.
