

Parking at Theatre/Dance Class and Performance Venues

The ISU Office of Public Safety monitors all parking lots during weekdays, and it is advisable for all students to obtain a general (yellow) parking permit through **Public Safety**. All parking is strictly enforced between 7:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

Stephens Performing Arts Center:

The large lot at the Stephens Center is a general (yellow) lot. The small lot near the Theatre/Dance offices is a reserved (red) lot. Students may park in any lot after 4 p.m. on weekdays. The loading zone off of the reserved lot is not available for parking during the day. Students without parking permits may find parking on Bartz Way near Sam Nixon Drive (the street that takes one into the reserved lot), but spaces are severely limited. Students must obey all municipal parking laws (i.e., yellow curbs, handicap zones, no-parking zones, etc.). “Visitor” parking spaces are not for student use.

The Red Hill Building:

Currently there are no general permit lots for the Red Hill Building. However, students are given after-hours access to two reserved lots near the building. The general lot near Reed Gymnasium is relatively nearby.

Frazier Hall:

The home of the Chick and Diane Bilyeu Theatre, is surrounded by a reserved lot only. All parking is strictly enforced between 7:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
