When we upgrade to Google Apps on October 6, your forwarding will be cancelled.

Please consider making your ISU email your primary address. You can set up your Google Apps at ISU account to collect your other email. Or you can get rid of extra addresses you no longer need. Your new account comes with 7gb of email storage space, and your ISU email address is now good for life. It won't expire.

However, if you want to keep sending your email to another account, you'll need to log in to Google Apps at ISU on October 6 **to set up forwarding again.** *You won't be able to log in to Google Apps at ISU unless you've changed your password.*
