Get Ready! Registration for Fall 2010 classes using our new system begins soon!

Go to bengalweb.isu.edu, log in, and click on the Academic Tools tab to see the Fall 2010 Class Schedule and other new features now available. Follow the steps below so that you will be ready when registration opens.

Step 1: Update Emergency Contacts

Pick someone ISU can contact if you are involved in an emergency. You must update your emergency contact before registering.

Step 2: Check My Registration Information

Anything blocking your registration? Check and see. Also verify your class level so you'll know when to register. Hint: If you do have any holds, look them up with the View Holds link.

Step 3: Search the ISU Class Schedule

Find the classes you want and write down their CRNs (new name for Index Number). Hint: When searching class schedule, you MUST select at least one Subject. Click on the CRN for class details and a link to the Course Catalog

Heads Up! Important Changes

- All course numbers are now 4 digits, i.e., English 101 has become English 1101
- Thursdays are shown as "R"
- Prerequisite, corequisite, and majors-only restrictions will be enforced – only the class instructor or the department chair can grant an override

Seniors, Graduate & Professional Students: April 19 (Mon) 8am

Juniors: April 21 (Wed) 8am

Sophomores: April 23 (Fri) 8am

Freshmen: April 26 (Mon) 8am
