When you've finished registering for Fall 2010, remember that you are not really done until you've looked at your Concise Schedule to see that you've registered for all the right classes. Here's how...

- Go to **BengalWeb**
- **Academic Tools** tab
- **Registration Tools** channel
- My **Concise Schedule** link
- Select a **Term**
- Then **Submit**

Carefully review your Concise Student Schedule for Fall 2010 to ensure that all courses, dates, times, etc., are correct.

Please note: Many classes now include prerequisites, corequisites, majors only, or instructor-specific permission requirements that must be met before you can register for them.

After you have added your classes, remember to check for messages listed below the classes you have been added to. These notices will indicate why a specific class was not successfully added to your schedule. Prerequisite restriction specific messages will ask you to contact the instructor (or call the department if the instructor is unavailable).

If granted an override, you must then go back into BengalWeb and register.

If everything is correct, you are ready to print your schedule. Go to the menu bar:

- Click **File**
- Then **Print**
- Select **Ok**
