Discussion focused on a draft of the classroom survey. The committee was comfortable with the range of questions. Devine asked that a question be added about general room aesthetics. The N/A category was debated as was the advisability of an odd or even number of answer choices. Groome suggested that the open ended question be limited to three prioritized entries. Reynolds asked that the format be quick and easy to use for faculty. Mickelson offered to find out about use of a Student Government survey generation package. It was agreed that the changes would be made and the survey administered in the next few weeks.
