OTHER REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Students applying for Classified status **MUST** submit scores for the Graduate Record Exam (**GRE**). Students who have not taken the appropriate exam may be considered for Conditional admission by **SOME** departments. Please contact the intended department or the Graduate School for more information. **NOTE:** Students admitted to Conditional status who have not taken the appropriate exam **may not be eligible for financial aid**, including the **Non-Resident Tuition Waiver**.
- Students applying for admission to programs in Counseling and Education may submit scores from the Miller Analogies Test (MAT) in lieu of GRE scores.
- Students applying for the MBA program must submit Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) scores rather than GRE scores.
- Students whose first language is not English, and who have not completed a degree program in the U.S., **MUST** submit TOEFL or IELTS scores. In some cases, students who have completed a degree program where English is the language of instruction may request a waiver of the TOEFL, subject to consideration of scores on the GRE, GMAT, or MAT, and other factors.
- Students **MUST** submit at least one official transcript with marks earned and degree posted from each institution at which credits have been earned. Official transcripts are those sent to the ISU Graduate School in an officially sealed envelope.
- If you are approved for admission, an I-20 cannot be issued until you have submitted the Declaration of Financial Support, and an official original current bank statement (in English) signed and stamped or sealed by a bank official.
