Welcome to the 2011 Bengal Marching Band!

Registration / Campus Housing Move-In

Registration will take place at the **FINE ARTS BUILDING** and this will be your first stop when you arrive on campus. (See Map) If you will be living in campus housing during the school year, we will inform them that you will be moving in early so you do not need to contact housing. When you register for band camp you will be given instructions on where to pick up your key.

If you are planning to live off-campus during the academic year, you should contact your individual landlord to make arrangements for early move-in. This is usually not a problem but if a conflict should occur, please contact us and we will assist you in finding accommodations during band camp.

Drumline Placement Sectional

Drumline placements will consist of playing in a full battery setting where members are encouraged to try as many instruments as they would like. Final decisions regarding instrument assignments will be made during this audition. All drumline members must download the **Drumline Packet** and prepare for whatever instruments you are interested in. Bass drum applicants will be asked to read on a variety of bass drum parts. Color Guard Placement Sectional

Color guard auditions are held as a sectional workshop where you will learn work that uses a variety of techniques. You will be evaluated throughout the audition process on your ability to execute and clean the work that is being taught during the workshop. Final decisions regarding placement will be made during band camp. Equipment will be provided, but you are welcome to bring your own equipment. Participants should dress to perform work and wear tennis or guard shoes.

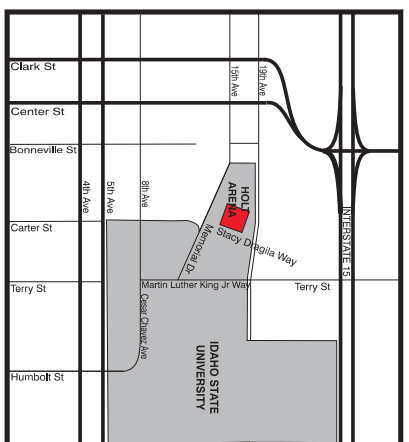

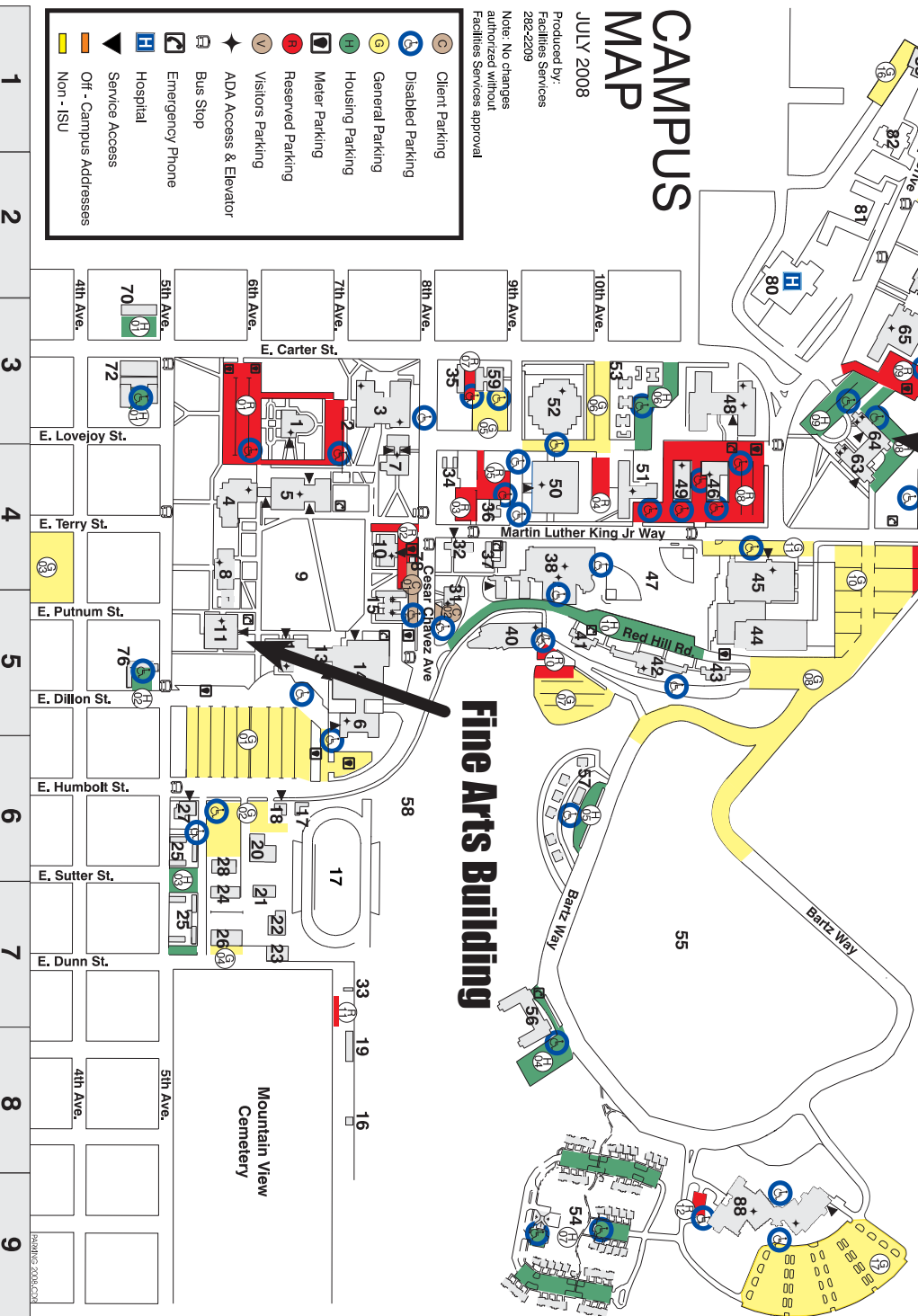
CAMPUS MAP
