- II. Announcements and Updates
- III. Report from Faculty Senate Meeting (Monday, October 25, 2021)
 - a. Kirkpatrick presented the process FPPC is going through to address changes that need to be made to ISUPP 4039
 - i. Faculty Senate was asked to give feedback based on her comments.
 - 1. No feedback has been received
 - b. President Satterlee said the Rendezvous Building will be renamed in honor of President Richard Bowen and his wife.

IV. Report from University Policy Manager, Libby Howe

- a. Emergency update of 3110, Equal Opportunity Harassment...
 - i. Policy needed to align with Federal Policy
- b. Alcohol Beverage Permitting Policy has been approved by Admin Council
 - i. Expect it to be signed by President Satterlee in the next few days
- c. ISUPP 4041 was reviewed by Admin Council but have tabled the discussion for a future meeting
- d. ISUPP 1020 was returned to its technical working group following a 30-day review to discuss a comment worthy of revisiting.
- V. Suspension, Dismissal, Termination for Cause (ISUPP 4039)

- a. Karl DeJesus Came to comment on his experience in using ISUPP 4039
 - i. Should panel members be tenured?
 - 1. DeJesus commented that the panel members need to be protected by tenure in case the issue at hand is a hot topic
 - ii. DeJesus supports longer terms for the panel members
 - iii. DeJesus supports panel members receiving training from HR
 - iv. Forest asked what DeJesus thought is a big problem in the current policy
 - 1. DeJesus said no "Big" problems
 - a. Be very careful to make sure the Administration does not stack the committee
 - b. Create a clause that will protect the witnesses
 - c. Important that the panel members decide and control how the process is run
 - v. Roche supports electing panel members by Faculty members
 - vi. Roche asked what the fear is of HR being involved in the process
 - 1. There is a potential that HR could have undue influence on the participants or the process
 - vii. Adams suggested finding a balance that would allow admin to choose the minority of the panel participants.
 - 1. E.G. Majority elected by Faculty and a few chosen by admin
- b. The composition of the appeals panel (continued from last FPPC meeting)
 - i. Possibility
 - 1. Follow the manner in which the Faculty Senate is constituted
 - a. Panel members would hold three-year terms
 - b. Elections would be staggered to keep panel members on who have some experience while new members begin their terms
 - ii. We have a directive to be mindful of workload-balance as we decide how to form the panel
 - iii. A discussion on tenure track vs. non-tenure track faculty being on the panel, ensued
 - iv. A discussion on how many representatives from each college are needed, ensued.
- c. How to get on the standing appeals panel
 - i. Barrott prefers the route to elect the panel members

<u>Action-</u> Forest motioned that we select "elected," as the means to get onto the appeals panel Barrott seconded

Motion carried with 7 yes's and 1 abstention

- d. Faculty Senate will be in charge of running the elections for the standing appeals panel
- e. Term limits

<u>ACTION-</u> Holland motioned to have 3-year staggered terms Byington seconded

Motion carried unanimously

f. Size of committee

ACTION- Barrott motioned to make the size of the committee 5 Byington seconded Motion Carried unanimously

- g. How will the committee be formed from the standing appeals panel
 - i. Suggested random draw by the faculty senate

ACTION- Forest motioned for faculty senate chair to randomly select the adhoc appeals panel from the standing appeals panel members Roche seconded Motion carried unanimously
