 - Recommendation: 80% reduction in computer stations (phased approach)
 - Current cost per year: \$63,652.26
 - Direct Impacts:
 - Sustainability - Reduction in CO2 emissions
 - Finances - Save approximately \$50,000 per year
 - Students - Rooms to be remodeled into supportive student spaces
