- 1. FY2022 Tuition & Fee Recommendations Jen
 - a. No increases to base undergraduate tuition and student activity fees
 - Graduate and non-resident tuition, eISU fees and professional fee increases will be considered
 - c. ACTION ITEM: determine how many of our graduate students pay full NR tuition
 - d. Feedback
 - i. It's important to maintain our focus on affordability
 - ii. Graduate students are not as against higher tuition when they find the right program in the right area
 - iii. If eISU fee moves forward, it would be beneficial to utilize funds to streamline our online delivery
