#### **Old Business**

1. The proposal letter to change the entrance of G10 has been submitted to Joseph Han. In addition, there is a donor interested in beautifying the area around Reed Gym, and so the entrance of G10 will probably be looked at during that time as well.
2. Discussion of parking by-laws and faculty/staff membership of the parking board. The question was raised on whether there should be one or two representatives from staff council on the parking board, which then brought about the question on whether there should be one or two faculty representatives. Steve Chatterton, Connie Gomez, Linda Tobias, and Laura Solomon will look into the by-laws and the issue will be voted on during the next parking board meeting.

#### **New Business**

1. Reduced fee for a second hangtag for employees

Questions have been raised on whether employees can purchase a reduced second permit for their vehicles so that they don't have to move a hang tag from one vehicle to another. The parking board discussed this and decided that we have a good policy in place and there is no need to change it.

2. Offering incentives for hang tags

There was a discussion about perhaps offering coupon books or some other kind of incentive for individuals on campus to purchase parking permits. Steve Chatterton said there would have to be approval from Kent Tingey's office and that he would look into it.

3. The old lines on the end of the R01 lot on the Pocatello campus need to be painted over with better black paint to cover up the white metallic paint. Steve Chatterton said that it would be taken care of.
4. Steve Chatterton raised the question about disabled parking and whether it needs to be enforced after hours. The parking board agreed that it needs to be enforced 24/7, no questions asked.
