- I. Amount of Scholarship: Variable–Not greater than one half of full-time resident tuition.
- II. Criteria for Eligibility:
 - A. Must have completed a minimum of 26 credit hours (sophomore level or above) by the end of the current semester to receive the award (exceptions for one-year programs).
 - B. Must be a full-time student at Idaho State University for:
 - 1. The semester immediately preceding the semester of application (excluding summer) (not required of graduate students), and
 - 2. The semester application is made, and
 - 3. The semester the award is received.

Full-time student status is defined as: Successful completion of a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester for undergraduate students and successful completion of 9 graduate credit hours per semester for graduate students. Additionally, the required minimum cumulative GPA must be maintained through the end of the semester of application in order to be eligible to receive an award. Graduating Seniors carrying 12 credit hours who have applied for and been accepted into the Graduate School should apply as Graduate Students. Previous semester credit hours may be in another major or ISU College.

- C. Scholarship:
 - 1. Undergraduate: All students with a minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA are encouraged to apply. The selection process may exclude students who have already received or will receive one or more other scholarships or awards. Although academic achievement will be the primary criterion for the awarding of scholarships, total semester credits earned will also be considered. A formula will be used giving 80% emphasis on GPA and 20% emphasis on total credits earned (with 128 credits being the maximum considered, except for pharmacy students).
 - 2. Graduate:
 - a. Ordinarily should meet the GRE/GMAT requirements for admission to candidacy, which is the 35th percentile in either verbal or quantitative portions of the test, graduating seniors excepted.
 - b. Ordinarily should meet undergraduate cumulative GPA of 2.75 over the last two years.
 - c. Cumulative GPA on graduate work, if any, must be a minimum of 3.00.
 - d. One letter of recommendation from the student's major department and/or advisor must be submitted with the application.
 - e. Selection will be coordinated through a scholarship selection committee in the Graduate School.
 - 3. **Students receiving a teaching or graduate fellowship/assistantship or other awards that pay for tuition are not eligible for an ASISU Scholarship.**
- D. Completed applications must be turned in to the scholarship office on or before **THE FRIDAY OF MID-TERM WEEK TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THE NEXT AWARD PERIOD.**
- E. Recipients are notified via e-mail (ISU e-mail account) if selected to receive an ASISU Scholarship.

- III. I have read the above criteria and agree to abide by them.
