Program Health and Sustainability Timeline and Update

The Program Health and Sustainability process is well underway at the program, department, and college levels. To support efforts to maintain transparency and inclusion throughout the process, Academic Affairs has created multiple opportunities for faculty to review action plan recommendations and provide feedback.

A detailed [timeline](#) is available online with links to additional supporting documents that explain the processes within the different phases. Below is a list of opportunities for faculty to review and provide feedback on action plans:

- Programs will originate action plans designed to improve program health based on guidance in the instructions and feedback from Faculty Senate, the Council of Deans, and Administrative Council (*Beginning February 19, 2021*)
- Review of Action Plans by Faculty/Programs for budget considerations (*Before March 5, 2021*)
- Faculty/Programs review of final action plans before submission to the State Board of Education (*May 10-14, 2021*)
- Faculty/programs review budget impacts of Action Plans prior to Deans submitting to Academic Affairs for FY22 budget considerations (*September 15, 2021*)
