The Human Subjects committee, Radiation Safety Committee, IACUC, and Institutional Biosafety Committee will continue to review protocols and be available to answer questions - contact Deb Easterly (eastdebb@isu.edu) for all compliance issues.

As long as ISU is open, research labs will remain open. Researchers should remember to maintain a social distance of at least 10 feet. Please rearrange lab schedules and operations as needed to accommodate this directive. This might include reducing the number of people in the lab at one time. Please allow researchers (faculty, staff and students) to conduct as much of their activities as possible from home. Please hold virtual lab meetings when at all possible. Please remember that student researchers may have returned to their permanent residences.

All Research Office staff, as long as they are healthy, will be available to communicate with you by phone or email. Call or write as you normally would.
