- Advising Update Cindy & Guest Corey Zink (15 minutes)
 - o 85%-90% of faculty submitted Navigate Reports. Advisors are turning these alerts into appointments with students.
 - O Academic Advising Charter build coordination and consistency in ISU Academic Advising (charter was closed November 2021).
 - Training on best practices of advising.
 - Every 1st and 2nd yr student has an assigned Academic Advisor
 - Revised and automated advisor assignment in Banner (always been a manual process and a significant change).
 - Revised Major Change process (CMR) Process to build and ready to go but there are some concerns.

- 4+1 Tuition Proposal Adam Bradford (10 minutes)
 - o Implement on a program by program basis at some of the outreach sites.
 - O Adam will circle back with Karen and Cindy and see what the feasibility is.
 - Starting conversation place is with BYU-Idaho.
- Turnitin Originality evaluators Lyle & Blake Beck (15 minutes)
 - Originality add-on: Intended to identify and reduce contract cheating. Faculty would contact the investigator to investigate the cheating allegation. If the writing is different or better that



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before or the name of the author is left on the work.

- O Built on a model that Universities have an Academic Integrity Officer. Most schools don't have a person to do this.
- O Do we have the resources to do this? Possible work load release, course release or stipend?
- Decision resolves around how quickly we want to start using this tool. Work load varies semester to semester.
- o Karen suggestion Deans take it back to leadership teams for feedback on the following:
 - How much do we see this happening?
 - And does this need to be discipline specific.
- Karen asked Deans to report at the next Council of Deans meetings scheduled for March 1, 2011 meeting as to how colleges approach this.

 - o Refer to the proposal. Hybrid model not assessed fee and asynchronous classes would be assessed the fee. \$35 fee would remain the same and maybe assessed later as we do a phased approach.
 - o Rationale for AO over SO equity and fairness.
 - O Concern about waiving of this fee.
 - O Unanimous vote to move proposal forward with the caveat that a group will be convened to assess needs moving forward.
