### IX. NEW BUSINESS

- a. Benny's Funding Request
  - i. Sigma Lambda Beta, \$3,000
    - 1. Senator Vargas Barvosa presented a funding request for Bailé Night, originally hosted by HALO, which this year will be a collaborative event organized by seven clubs. Interested Men of Sigma Lambda Beta, Lambda Theta Alpha Latin Sorority, Inc., Lambda Theta Phi Latin Fraternity, Sigma Lambda Gamma, Society of the Advancement of Chicanos/Hispanics and Native Americans in Science at ISU, Hispanic Awareness Leadership Organization, and Los Estudiantes Despues. Last year, the event cost \$3,500. The ballroom has been booked for March, and the event is a nonprofit initiative aimed at raising awareness among Latinx and Hispanic students and ensuring a safe, welcoming space. They are seeking approximately 30 outside sponsors.
      - a. President Halter questioned whether attendance might be affected since the event is scheduled just before spring break.
      - Senator Vargas Barvosa suggested encouraging community attendance and starting advertising early to maximize participation. Expected attendance is 200–300 people.
  - ii. Martin Luther King Jr. Beloved Community Club and Nutrition and Wellness Club, \$3,000
    - Michael Strikeland presented a funding request to honor the legacy of Martin Luther
      King Jr. by combining efforts of the MLK Beloved Community Club and the Nutrition
      Club. The event will include a panel discussion following the MLK march and a free
      healthy soul food luncheon for students and the community. The Student Leadership
      and Engagement Center will manage marketing.
      - Senator Saunders asked whether the event would be free or if people would have to pay to attend.
      - Michael Strikeland shared that is will be free for students, but community access has not been determined yet.
      - Dr. Matt Daily noted that this is the only official MLK celebration in the city, though there is no formal connection with city officials, who will attend.

- d. Michael Strikeland shared that marketing will be managed by Val Davids using flyers, the clubs' websites, and Instagram accounts. If approved, ASISU will be included on promotional materials. The menu will include, grilled chicken, roast beef, mashed potatoes with gravy, collard greens, corn, and cranberry sauce. In the interest of nutrition and wellness, no fried foods will be served.
