This bill updates ASISU bylaws, Article I Section 3 Clause 2 to reflect the change of the College of Nursing and the College Rehabilitation and Communication Sciences to the School of Nursing and School of Rehabilitation and Communication Sciences.

Clause 2—The following will be considered as a college for election purposes: the College of Arts and Letters, the College of Science and Engineering, the College of Business, the School of Graduate Studies, the College of Technology, the College of Pharmacy, the College of Education, ~~the College of Nursing, and the College of Health Professions, and the College of Rehabilitation and Communication Sciences.~~

- A. The School of Nursing will have its own senator under the College of Health, named Senator for the School of Nursing.
- B. The School of Rehabilitation and Communication Sciences will have its own senator under the College of Health, named Senator for the School of Rehabilitation and Communication Sciences.
- C. If the College of Health only receives two senators for an academic year, then the largest school, based on enrollment numbers, out of the School of Nursing and School of Rehabilitation and Communication Sciences will receive the second senator.
