For 2019 Graduates

THE HIGHLIGHTS

- The survey included graduates from spring, summer and fall 2019 graduations
- Graduates were surveyed over a 6-month period which conforms with the National Association of Colleges and Employers standard
- 87.5% of respondents are working or continuing their education within Idaho
- 72.6% of respondents stated that their position is somewhat to strongly related to their degree/major
- 67.9% of respondents who are continuing their education chose ISU
- 36% of respondents participated in a Career Path Internship (CPI)
- 67.3% of respondents believe their CPI was beneficial in their job search

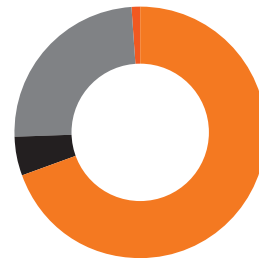

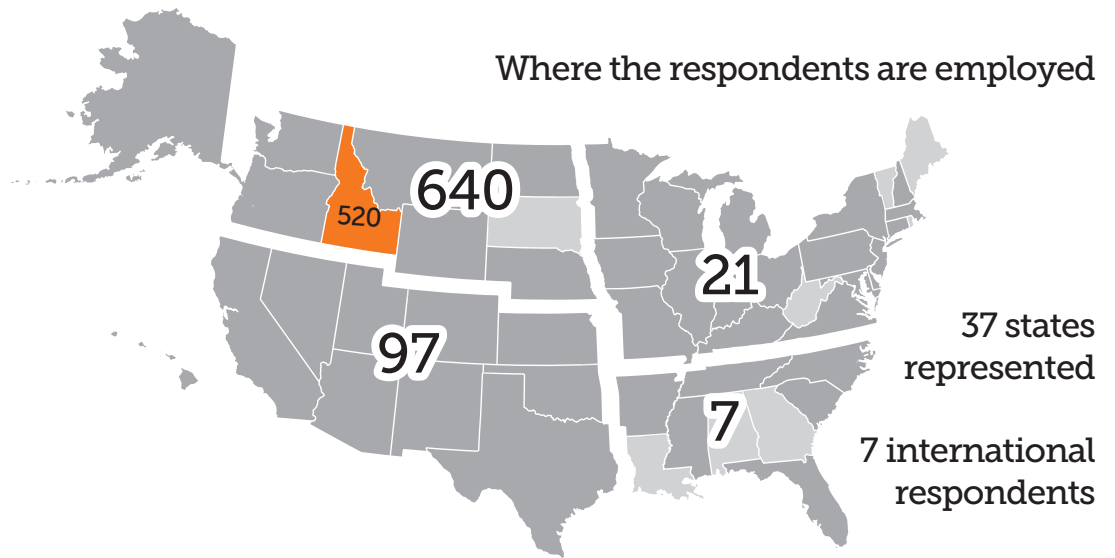
