

Employment Facts For 2018 Graduates

THE HIGHLIGHTS

- Survey included the graduates from spring, summer and fall 2018 graduations
- Graduates were surveyed over a 6-month period which conforms with the National Association of Colleges and Employers standard
- 72.5% of graduates are working or continuing their education just in Idaho
- 70% of respondents stated that their position is somewhat to strongly related to their degree/major
- 40% of respondents participated in a Career Path Internship (CPI)
- 66% of respondents believe CPI helped in their job search
- 40% of respondents had at least 1 individual appointment with the Career Center

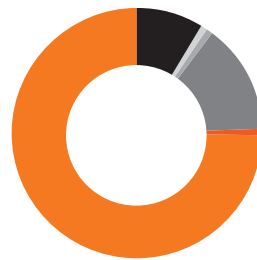

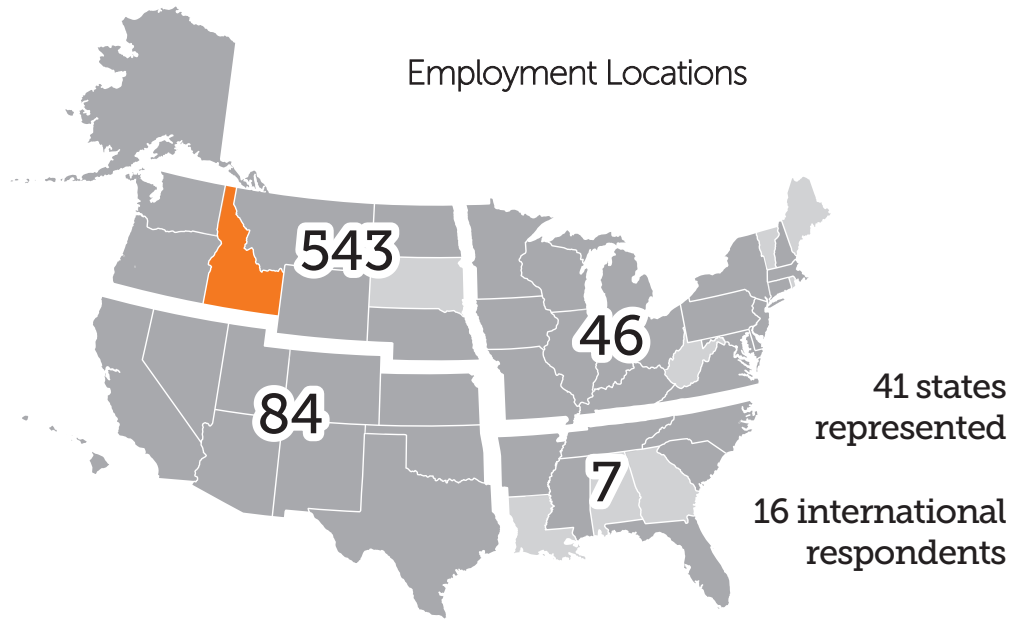
