ON CAMPUS REGISTRATION DEADLINE: January 13, 2023

Registration Steps:

Step 1: Apply to the Early College Program – <https://www.isu.edu/apply/early-college/>
*Note: You only need to apply **once** to the Early College Program. If you have already been admitted, please skip to step 4.*

Step 2: Submit signed Consent Form – found at www.isu.edu/ecp/forms/
Note: If you are 18 years of age, a parent signature is not needed. Please use the print version of the consent form and return it to your CCA, Counselor, email to ecp@isu.edu, or use our upload link at www.isu.edu/ecp/forms/.

Step 3: Get username and password – Once you are admitted, please check your email (and spam folders) for “Claim Account” information from jam@isu.edu. Set up your BengalWeb username and password. For additional assistance, call the IT Service desk at 208-282-4357.

Step 4: Register for classes.
 - Login to BengalWeb (bengalweb.isu.edu) – Use forgot password link if needed. Call IT Service desk at 208-282-4357 for additional login assistance.
 - Click on the **Academic Tools** tab in the left menu bar
 - In the **Registration Tools** box, click **Register for Classes (Add or Drop Classes)** link
 - In the Select a Term drop down menu click on **Fall 2022**
 - If this is your first time registering for classes in BengalWeb, you will be prompted to add an emergency contact. After you enter your contact information, click proceed to registration at the bottom of the page.
 - You will be asked to agree to the financial terms and conditions of taking a course. Choose your answer and click update. (You may have to do this for all open registration term, whether or not you are taking a class during those terms).
 - On the Register for Classes page, click on the Enter CRNs tab
 Enter the CRN for the course you want to take into the CRN field and click **Add to Summary**
 To finalize your registration, click Submit on the bottom of the screen. The course status will change from **Pending** to **Registered** if you were successfully registered for the course. If you were NOT, an error message will appear, explaining the problem.

Step 5: Request Advanced Opportunities Funding if Eligible

Step 6: Submit On-Campus Liability Waiver Form
 - This form can be found at www.isu.edu/ecp/forms/
 - **All Students** taking a course taught by an on-campus ISU professor must submit an On-Campus Liability Waiver Form to the Early College Program office prior to their first day of courses. This form is only required once. If you are not sure if you have already submitted one, please contact the ECP office at 208-282-6067.
