- 4. Gather Application Materials:
 - a. Transcripts
 - b. Two letters of recommendation (provide name and contact info). They will be contacted directly for a confidential recommendation request.
 - c. Self-Reflection Essay (5 pg, double spaced).
 - d. Resume or Curricula Vitae (CV)
 - e. Application Fee \$65
- 5. Apply on the ISU Graduate Programs Website https://www.isu.edu/apply/
 - a. Create an Account
- 6. A GPA of 3.0 or higher. Students who do not meet the minimum GPA may be admitted conditionally with performance requirements.
- 7. Background Check Acknowledgement
- 8. Undergraduate prerequisite course (one of the 10 courses): Applicants with a BS/BA degree in a field not closely related to Homeland Security or Emergency Management must complete HSEM 3301 Overview to Homeland Security and Emergency Management as a program prerequisite, despite work experience.

¹ All online HSEM students will receive a non-resident tuition waiver regardless of residency.

² The average in-state graduate tuition for the 21-22 academic year is \$555 per credit (fees included).



Homeland Security and Emergency Management

- a. HSEM 3301 is offered in the Summer semester prior to the MS degree start date.
- 9. ISU HSEM undergraduate students may apply to enter the MS program during their fourth year and have the option to take two BS courses at the MS level.
- 10. Admission Interview: Once your file is complete you may be contacted for an interview.

International Applicants:

International students must complete the Statement of Financial Guarantee.

Applicants educated in an institution where English is not the language of instruction are required to submit official score results for TOEFL (internet-based test score of 80 or paper-based test score of 550), IELTS (6.5). Please contact the International Program Office for more details.

Exception: International students whose undergraduate education took place in Australia, Canada (English-speaking provinces), United Kingdom, Ireland, New Zealand, or the U.S. are exempt from this requirement. Students born in one of these countries yet educated elsewhere are still required to satisfy the English proficiency requirement.
