# **Biological Sciences Laboratory Instruction**

Regardless of a student's future pursuits in the field of biological sciences, the introduction to biological processes and protocols in a laboratory setting can only expand a student's view of the world. The effective implementation of laboratories is necessary if students are to acquire a basic foundation in the biological sciences and a broad worldview.

Adjunct, GTA, and CPI instructor contracts are 18 weeks long; summer session teaching appointments are 4 or 6 weeks long. It is contractually expected that instructors; 1) teach all the labs they are on contract for, 2) grade all assignments, 3) attend instructor meetings, 4) clean/maintain the teaching laboratory, 5) proctor exams, 6) attend the course lecture, and 7) attend 208 tutoring/office hours.
