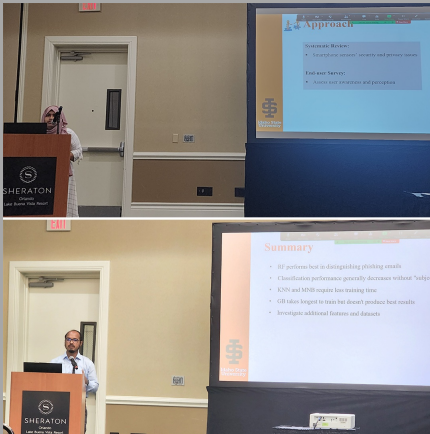




## What's Happening in CoSE



Last week, computer science graduate students Arifa Islam Champa and Md Fazle Rabbi presented a pair of papers at the IEEE/ACIS International Conference on Software Engineering Research, Management and Applications in Orlando, Florida.

Arifa's paper dives into the security and privacy risks around the many different sensors in your smartphone and what users may or may not know about the potential cybersecurity threats they pose.

Meanwhile, Md Fazle's paper compares six machine learning algorithms for their effectiveness in detecting one of the most common scams, the phishing email.

Both papers are set to be published in Springer's Studies in Computational Intelligence series. They were co-authored by Minhaz Zibran, associate professor, and Farjana Eishita, assistant professor.
