Science & engineering doctoral candidates, recent Ph.D.s, postdocs, certain engineering MS students, & junior faculty who are U.S. Citizens or legal permanent residents (and a very limited number of Foreign Nationals from non-designated countries) are eligible to apply for NASA Science Mission Design Schools career development experiences.

Offered by the Jet Propulsion Laboratory in Pasadena, CA, the Planetary Science Summer School focuses on planetary exploration and is a 3-month long career development experience to learn the development of a hypothesis-driven robotic space mission in a concurrent engineering environment while getting an in-depth, first-hand look at mission design, life cycle, costs, schedule & the trade-offs inherent in each.
