

ALEKS Math Placement Summary

As of: 11.29.2016

Beginning December 1, 2016, COMPASS is no longer offered and will be replaced by the ALEKS placement exam. COMPASS scores can be used for placement through Spring 2018 semester (if taken within the last seven years and prior to December 1st, 2016).

- Students who have applied to ISU may take the ALEKS Math Assessment at no cost.
- Students are allowed five (5) attempts.
- After the first attempt and before re-testing a second, third or fourth time, the student must spend five (5) hours actively working in the ALEKS Prep and Learning Module.
- ALEKS carefully tracks the required five (5) hours in the Prep and Learning Module.
- Students have six (6) months access to the ALEKS tutorial (i.e. Prep and Learning Module) to practice and improve skills.
- Students have one (1) year to complete the five (5) attempts.
- After the no-cost five (5) attempts, students will be charged a fee if they choose to take additional ALEKS assessments.
- All five (5) ALEKS assessment attempts will be proctored (supervised).
- The first attempt, however, can be non-proctored upon student request.
- A non-proctored assessment allows the student up to 24 hours to complete the assessment while becoming familiar with the ALEKS system at their home or other location of their choosing.
- Non-proctored assessment scores are not recorded in the ISU Banner system and do not qualify as official scores for math placement.
