Admission Criteria

Minimum Requirements:

- Completion of the following prerequisite courses or equivalent with a grade of “C” or better: ENGL 1101 & 1102: PSYC 1101: NTD 2239 (Preferred) or 3340: BIOL 2221/2221L, BIOL 2227/2227L or BIOL 3301/3301L, BIOL 3302/3302L: MATH (Goal 3) MATH 1153 preferred): COMM 1101.
- A cumulative grade point average of 2.5 is required.
- Active unrestricted licensure to practice as an LPN in the State of Idaho
- Current CPR certification (Healthcare Provider) from the American Heart Association or the American Red Cross.
- Proof of IV Therapy certification completion
- Current immunization and good health status per program policy, upon conditional acceptance into the program.
- Background check and drug screening per department policy, upon acceptance into the program.

**\*After meeting the minimum requirements above, students are ranked based on the point system as follows:**
