5.1. Outstanding Faculty Achievement Award -*Val Williams*

- There's nothing to be done until February when we send out the notification of submissions.

5.2. Rank and Promotion - *Robert Liimakka (C) Wade Lowry (exofficio)*

- Working with ITRC, Kathy Levitt, and she's helping us to import the application, Rank and Promotion application into Canvas.
- And it's our goal is to do this year a test phase and with full implementation in testing. If it's successful, we're going to bring that to Academic Affairs and hopefully to convince them that we should move on from Box to Canvas.

University Committees

6.1 Faculty Senate *Dave Smith*

- The way that student evaluations are being done are going to change a little bit. They're going to a Canvas platform called Watermark. That process will be pushed through this semester. So once that is



completed, you'll be able to see your evaluations in your course pretty much as soon as the semester is over. They won't need to go through admins anymore.

- They won't need to have information sifted out of them. (like the student identifiers.)
- The other evaluation piece is that we're having a revision to our annual evaluation process for the way that we submit those and the way that we are graded on those, moving away from the five-rating scale that we've had to potentially a four-rating scale. The four categories would be an exceptional, an above expectations, a meets expectations, and then a does not meet expectations.
- Question: Is there any kind of a difference in the pay raise scale because of it? How did they differentiate?
- Answer: The truth is that we don't really know yet what that would look like on a pay raise scale. More to come on this topic after senate meets with HR. Committee feels there should be some really clear guidelines and training, for chairs.
- Action item Jeremy will follow up and check with the dean's office and see if that's going to be used or how it's going to be used?
- The 3% holdback that's going through, which decreases our university overall budget by 3% for this year. It was discussed initially as being just a holdback for this year, but it looks like that will be a permanent 3% decrease in our university budget, which if you know what the university budget is, that is a ton of money.

6.2 Scholarship Committee *George Lake*

- Met and distributed one scholarship, but nothing other than that to really report on.

6.3 GERC - *Elizabeth Tubbs*

- GERC, they're reviewing new bylaws. Informal survey has been approved to gauge perceptions about gen ed programs.
- GEM award ceremony today. It's a general education ceremony. They are developing a template for updated assessment plans for all GE courses.
- Alex Hrin is our representative for that. If you have any questions, I can either forward that to Alex Hrin or maybe ask him to attend to answer those questions.

- UCC is working on new proposal or going through and reviewing proposals. Reminder, the deadline for new proposals is October 20th, so you don't have very much time if you're trying to put together proposals to make sure you get that in.

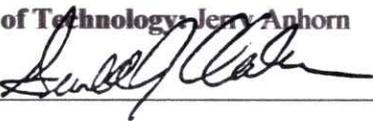
