## Career Path Internship (CPI) Program - Qualification for Eligibility:

- 1. Student must be a major in Surveying and Geomatics Engineering Technology
- 2. Good academic standing.
- 3. Full time student (12 or more credits)
- 4. Department will pay up to 20 hours/week as funding allows.
- 5. Student is limited to 20 hours/week.
- 6. Students are encouraged to hold off-campus CPIs within the State of Idaho as long as they are a current ISU student and have approval from their faculty advisor, department chair and respective dean.
- 7. Dates of employment and hours worked will be coordinated with the employer and department chair.
- 8. CPI positions may be competitive in nature, and may require additional criteria such as submitting a resume and/or being interviewed.
