Estimated Campus SLP Program Tuition and Fees for the 5-Semester Program of Study

An estimated cost for the 5-semester campus SLP graduate program for a non-thesis-track student is shown below, using the current 2026/2027 rates. A thesis track would involve 4 additional credits. Graduate tuition for our online program is currently offered at the resident rate for Idaho residents and residents of states participating in the WRPG program. There will also be an additional \$5 charge per semester for malpractice insurance. ISU maintains this policy for you.

Full Time (9 credits or more) Resident Graduate Tuition: \$5820.00, plus professional fee of \$246 per credit hour.

*This estimate is using the 2026/2027 tuition and fee rates. Keep in mind, tuition generally increases each fall semester. The final program cost is approximate, as it is based on current rates. As soon as the 2027/2028 rates are available, they will be posted.
