

Addiction Studies Academic Certificate Admission Criteria (Undergraduate)

Please note: *This is not an application to enroll as a student at ISU. In addition to program criteria, you must meet all criteria for acceptance into Idaho State University. You may complete your enrollment prior to or after completing the program electronic application.*

To apply for the Undergraduate Addiction Studies Academic Certificate submit the following documents:

1. **Addiction Studies Academic Certificate Application:** Please see below.
2. **Statement of Intent:** Submit a typed essay (one to two pages, single spaced) describing the applicant's interest in pursuing the Undergraduate Certificate in Addiction Studies and a vision of how the certificate will facilitate the applicant's career goals.
3. **Letter of Recommendation:** Submit one letter of recommendation from a non-relative individual familiar with the applicant's academic or professional abilities (no personal references).
4. **Acceptance to Idaho State University:** If needed, complete your ISU Application for Admission online at <https://www.isu.edu/apply/>. When applying, select "Addiction Studies Academic Certificate" as your major. Please submit an application at least 30 days before the start of the semester to allow for processing.

Addiction Studies Academic Certificate Admission Criteria (Graduate)

Please note: *This is not an application to enroll as a student at ISU. In addition to program criteria, you must meet all criteria for acceptance into Idaho State University Graduate School via CollegeNet. You may complete your enrollment prior to or after completing the program electronic application.*

To apply for the Graduate Addiction Studies Academic Certificate submit the following documents:

1. **Addiction Studies Academic Certificate Application:** Please see below.
2. **Official College Transcripts:** All applicants must submit official college transcripts to the ISU Graduate School. Applicants must have a cumulative undergraduate grade point of at least 3.0 upper division (3000-4000 level) courses. Applicants who have started or completed a graduate-level degree must also have a graduate grade point average of at least 3.0.
3. **Background Check:** Applicants must affirm the ability to pass the State of Idaho Department of Health and Welfare background check.
4. **Statement of Intent:** Submit a typed essay (one to two pages, single spaced) describing the applicant's interest in pursuing the Graduate Certificate in Addiction Studies and a vision of how the certificate will facilitate the applicant's career goals.
5. **Letter of Recommendation:** Submit one letter of recommendation from a non-relative individual familiar with the applicant's academic or professional abilities (no personal references).
6. **International Students:** International students who have not graduated from an accredited college or university in the United States, and whose native language is not English, must

achieve satisfactory scores on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL). Satisfactory TOEFL requirements for classified admission are described in the Idaho State University Graduate Catalog under "Admission of International Students."
