## Schedule Type and Class Instruction Definitions

Schedule Type Code	Schedule Code Description	Definition of Instruction
<b>AO</b>	Fully Online - No set meeting time	<p>Fully Online course</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Coursework delivery via: web, email, and/or message boards in online forums such as Moodle, Google groups, etc.</li> <li>Course is most often delivered using Moodle.</li> <li>Courses are NOT time or place dependent</li> </ul>
<b>BL</b>	Blended - reduced in class time	<p>Reduced in person seat time</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A combination of face-to-face classroom combined with online days that do not require a student to be in a certain place at a certain time.</li> </ul> <p>For example, a three-credit course meets only Monday and Wednesday in a classroom (for an hour each class period) and then equivalent material is delivered online in place of a Friday class (33% of the class is online).</p>
<b>CL</b>	Standard Classroom	Standard Lecture in the Classroom
<b>FX</b>	Standard Classroom and Zoom	<p>Face-to-Face and/or Online course option</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>HyFlex is a course design model that presents the components of face-to-face classroom learning in a flexible course structure that gives students the option of attending sessions in the classroom, participating via Zoom, or doing both.</li> <li>Students can change their mode of attendance weekly or by topic, according to need or preference and in consultation with their faculty member.</li> </ul>
<b>LB</b>	Lab	<p>Lab or Studio</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Class requires specialized equipment in the classroom.</li> </ul>
<b>OL</b>	Mostly Online - Moodle	The majority of the course is online but may require up to five in person meetings.
<b>OT</b>	Other	Dissertation, Thesis, Practicum, Rotations
<b>SO</b>	Fully Online with set meeting time	<p>Fully Online course via Zoom with set meeting times</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Online course where students and faculty are together at the same time (mountain standard MST) and will be using the Zoom platform for instruction and class discussions.</li> </ul>
<b>VS</b>	Dedicated Video Conf Classroom	<p>Video Conference Network</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dedicated classroom at an ISU campus location. Individual remote connections are also possible (contact ITRC).</li> </ul>
