- a. Update on Five Year Review Policy (ISUPP 4010)
 - i. Implementing an interim 5 year review policy
 - 1. That cannot happen due to legal ramifications
 - 2. Must continue to use currently established five year review policy
- b. Update on Academic Rank and Other Appointments (ISUPP 4050)
 - i. This policy was sent forward for 30-day review after the Faculty Senate approved the policy.
