Math (3cr)	MATH 0090 or higher	Placement will depend on SAT or ACT or ALEKS test score. (Register for Math 0090 if you do not have ACT/SAT/ALEKS scores. You will be allowed to change your course registration after testing on campus. ALEKS Mathematics Placement test is offered free of cost and can be taken once you arrive at ISU)
Art (3cr)	ART 1100	Introduction to Art (Objective 4)
Sociology (3 cr) <b>OR</b> Psychology (3 cr)	SOC 1101 <b>OR</b> PSYC 1101	Introduction to Sociology (Objective 6) <b>OR</b> Introduction to Psychology (Objective 6)
Academic Skills (2 cr)	ACAD 1104	Introduction to University
