English (3cr)	ENGL 1122 or 1123 or 1101 P or 1101	Placement will depend on IELTS or TOEFL score. Students without TOEFL or IELTS scores, contact Amanda Christensen at (chriama5@isu.edu) for placement. Include your full name and ISU Student ID number in your email. <u>Subject Line of the email should be:</u> Permission to Register Needed.
Math (3cr)	MATH 0090	Placement will depend on SAT or ACT or ALEKS test score. (Register for Math 0090 if you do not have ACT/SAT/ALEKS scores. You will be allowed to change your course registration after testing on campus. ALEKS Mathematics Placement test is offered free of cost and can be taken once you arrive at ISU)
Art 1100 (3cr)	ART 1100	Introduction to Art (Objective 4)
Anthropology (3cr) OR International Studies (3cr)	ANTH 1100 OR GLBL 2203	Introduction to Anthropology (Objective 6) OR Introduction to International Organizations (Objective 6)
Academic Skills	ACAD 1104	Introduction to University
