Personal Essay Instructions

Type a two page (no more than two), double spaced essay. Use your own words to create a personal essay that responds to the question below.

Your personal essay should address why you selected OT as a career and state your immediate and long term professional goals. Describe how your personal, educational, and professional background will help you to achieve your goals.

Please compose this essay yourself. This essay will be evaluated for organization, writing style, grammar, and punctuation. At the time of your interview applicants may be asked to write another essay. The two essays will be compared for consistency in writing style, grammar, etc.

You must sign your legal signature at the end of the essay to indicate authorship. (Only signed essays will be accepted.)

Letters of Reference

Please submit 3 letters of reference with your application: One from an occupational therapist or occupational therapy assistant who served as a supervisor for a portion of the observation/ volunteering hours, one from an academic teacher or advisor, and one from a person acquainted with the student who is able to testify to the nature of the student's character (employer, clergy, etc.). No letters from relatives of the student are acceptable.

Letters of reference should be submitted in a sealed envelope with the author's signature across the seal. The author of the letter should include the following information within the letter.

- Name of Applicant
- Author Name
- Author's Title/Profession
- Statement as to whether author directly supervised the applicant in an Occupational Therapy Department
- Name and location of clinical or other setting in which author came to know the applicant
- Length of time author has known applicant
- A brief summary of the author's impression of the applicant's academic ability, personality characteristics (e.g. integrity, dependability, ability to get along with others), and potential for success in the profession of occupational therapy (if known). Illustrate with specific examples whenever possible

Observation Hours

A minimum of 40 hours accumulated in to different practice settings should be completed prior to applying to the Pre-OT accelerated concentration process. Documentation of the experience should be completed by the occupational therapy practitioner supervising the experience using the form provided.
