

# FOCUSING YOUR PA POTENTIAL

## *with health tracks & graduate certificates*

### GRADUATE CERTIFICATES

Any graduate student can pursue a graduate certificate, even if you're not part of a program-hosted track. Some aren't built to coincide well with PA school: PA students can only take 3 additional credits each semester on top of the PA curriculum. Be sure to check with the certificate program to see if it'll work for you. It'll require another Graduate School application.

### RURAL HEALTH TRACK

- 12 PA students: 4 in POC; 8 in MER/CALD
- AHEC Scholar certificate
- 1 of 4 other certificates you choose:
  - Spanish for Health Professions
  - Geriatrics
  - Rural Health
  - Lifestyle Medicine
- 2 back-to-back rotations in a rural clinic
- ~\$5,000 stipend in the clinical year
- Requires 3 applications:
  - an internal application,
  - an AHEC Scholars application,
  - a Graduate School application to the certificate you choose



### LATINO HEALTH TRACK

- 4-5 PA students, not restricted by campus
- Spanish for Health Professions certificate
- 5 rotations guaranteed at Latin-dense clinics
- Stipend dependent on external funding
- Requires 2 applications:
  - an internal application,
  - a Graduate School application to the SHP certificate
