Admission Criteria

The following are the minimum requirement for admission to the DMS program is one of the following:

- ARRT RT (R) registered or registry eligible/graduating from radiography program

OR

- Hold an AAS, AS, OR BS Degree in a medically-related field
Complete a minimum of 12-Months of patient care **patient care must include direct hands-on care with patients involving patient transferring, sterile field setup, wheelchair and stretcher experience, and other tasks. CNA or MA work is preferred. Administrative work is not considered.**

Admission Procedure

For the Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program the following must be completed and received by February 1st for the upcoming Fall semester. If the 1st falls on a weekend, the deadline is the preceding Friday.

A complete application consists of the following five items:

1. Admission to Idaho State University
2. Completed application form for the Sonography Program
3. Official college transcripts of ALL completed course work
4. Verification of Imaging credentials or previous degree and patient care experience
5. A non-refundable \$100 application fee, payable to the Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program. If paid online include copy of receipt with application
