Admission Procedure

For the Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program the following must be completed and received by February 1st for the upcoming Fall semester. If the 1st falls on a weekend, the deadlines is the preceding Friday.

A complete application consists of the following five items:

- 1. Admission to Idaho State University
- 2. Completed application form for the Sonography Program
- 3. Official college transcripts of ALL completed course work
- 4. Verification of Imaging credentials or previous degree and patient care experience
- 5.A non-refundable \$100 application fee, payable to the Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program. If paid online include copy of receipt with application
