- 1. Apply for admission to Idaho State University
- 2. Completion of ALL required General Education and prerequisite courses (minimum GPA of 3.0 required.)
- 3. Submit Transcripts & Application a. Send official ISU and ALL college transcripts directly via Registrar, Parchment, or Clearinghouse to robingardner@isu.edu b. Applicant-submitted copies
- 4. A non-refundable \$100 application fee, payable to the Radiographic Science Program. If paid online include copy of receipt with application
