IDAHO RESIDENCY FOR TUITION PURPOSES
PROOF OF LAWFUL PRESENCE REQUIREMENTS FOR NON-U.S. CITIZENS

If you are not a citizen of the United States, but claim to be a resident of Idaho, pursuant to Idaho Code Sections 33-3717B(3)(b) and 67-7903(4)(b), you must provide proof of lawful presence in the United States by providing documentation of your status and completing an Attestation of Lawful Presence.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION:

In order for Idaho State University to verify your lawful presence in the United States, you must provide a valid social security number and **one of the following:**

- (1) An Idaho driver's license or an Idaho identification card issued pursuant to section 49-2444, Idaho Code; *or*
- (2) A valid driver's license or similar document issued for the purpose of identification by another state or territory of the United States, if such license or document contains a photograph of the individual or such other personal identifying information relating to the individual that the director of the department of health and welfare or, with regard to unemployment compensation benefits, the director of the department of labor finds, by rule, sufficient for purposes of this section; *or*
- (3) A United States military card or a military dependent's identification card; *or*
- (4) A United States coast guard merchant mariner card; *or*
- (5) A native American tribal document; *or*
- (6) A copy of an executive office of immigration review, immigration judge or board of immigration appeals decision, granting asylee status; *or*
- (7) A copy of an executive office of immigration review, immigration judge or board of immigration appeals decision, indicating that the individual may lawfully remain in the United States; *or*
- (8) Any United States citizenship and immigration service issued document showing refugee or asylee status or that the individual may lawfully remain in the United States; *or*
- (9) Any department of state or customs and border protection issued document showing the individual has been permitted entry into the United States on the basis of refugee or asylee status, or on any other basis that permits the individual to lawfully enter and remain in the United States; *or*
- (10) A valid United States passport.

ATTESTATION OF LAWFUL PRESENCE: In addition to providing the required documentation, you must certify under the penalty of perjury that you are lawfully present in the United States by completing the Attestation of Lawful Presence. Idaho State University may require you to appear in person to verify your identity and to physically examine the document(s) provided to determine whether the document(s) reasonably appears to be genuine and related to you.

VERIFICATION PROCESS: As necessary, the University may verify lawful presence in the United States with federal agencies and using federal services such as, but not limited to, the Systematic Alien Verification of Entitlement program (SAVE), or the Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) database.
